Welcome back to a brand new term at Chad Vale Primary School; we hope you had a relaxing and enjoyable summer break despite the miserable Birmingham weather. As you will have seen (and heard), the building work has progressed very quickly over the holiday and the team completed lots of jobs around the site that were made considerably easier without having to navigate their way around 450+ people. The main changes, that are now complete (or almost complete) are:


- Extended and improved school hall; the old brick built PE stores has been demolished and the hall extended fully to incorporate this area. We have new flooring, radiators, lighting and a new built PE storage extension so that sports and PE equipment remains easily accessible. We have already been making the most of the additional space for whole school assemblies, PE and dinnertimes and are currently trialling different ways of using this space for maximum efficiency.
- Brand new staff room in the new extension to the main building; this area can now fit all of our staff inside for weekly briefings and training and provides a better workspace for teachers to carry out assessments and planning.
- New office spaces have been created in the old staff room areas and currently house Mr. Sansom, Miss Crombie and Mr
 Dubberley whilst their original offices are being refurbished. The final use of these rooms is likely to change in the next
 few weeks and we'll keep you posted!
- Brand new large play equipment on the field, funded by the PPTA and a Big Lottery Grant; the children have thoroughly
 enjoyed trying out our new 'trim trail'; the monkey bars have been particularly challenging and enjoyable for the older
 children!
- New small learning areas have been created in the downstairs new build extension; these are currently temporary but
 will become more permanent in the next few weeks. They will help to provide much better facilities for supporting xchildren with English as an Additional Language and special educational needs.
- A brand new library, downstairs in the new build extension; this room is currently being used for storage, but over the next few weeks will be transfored into a wonderful room full of books to help inspire learning and enhance the love of reading; a bonus to this is the clearing of all the books and cupboards previously stored in the corridors, that means its much easier now to get around school.

If you would like to come into school to have a look at all the changes, please feel to do so; please just sign in on screen in the entrance. Work continues on improvements on the school field and in the main office area, and we'll keep you further updated over the next few weeks.

Collecting children- please remember that you must inform the school office if someone other than the 'usual parent' is collecting your child. We cannot release your child to an unknown adult! Thank-you for your co-operation on this matter.

It was with great sadness to learn of the death of two ex-Chad Vale parents this week in the Birmingham Mail. Both parents passed away over the summer of untreatable medical conditions, leaving their five boys orphaned. The four eldest boys attended Chad Vale Primary School and the staff have requested that we make a 'Chad Vale Family' donation to their online

fundraising account on GoFundMe. This fundraising page has already raised in excess of £80,000 to help support the boys during this difficult time and in the future. For those parents who remember Omena and Makeda Ubiaro, or who remember their lovely boys; Khariis, Cairo, Ramiyah and Macaiah we will be carrying out a 'bucket shake' collection on the gate next week. 

Coach & Player Pathways


Our Football Development programme supports our Player Pathway Model which is designed to create more opportunities for all ages and abilities.
