Today, at 11am, we remembered everyone who has died in war and conflict around the world with a one minute silence. The children and adults stopped whatever they were doing and stood or sat in silence across the whole school. Prior to this, the teachers talked to the children about why this year is particularly special, remembering the 100th anniversary of the end of the First World War.

For our teacher training day on Monday, we talked in great depth about the reasons why we teach certain subjects at Chad Vale. We believe its very important for the children to learn about the past, so that they can help us to improve our futures. This week the children have learned lots about history, conflict, resolution, respect and courage, and we've been moved at how understanding and caring the children have been. 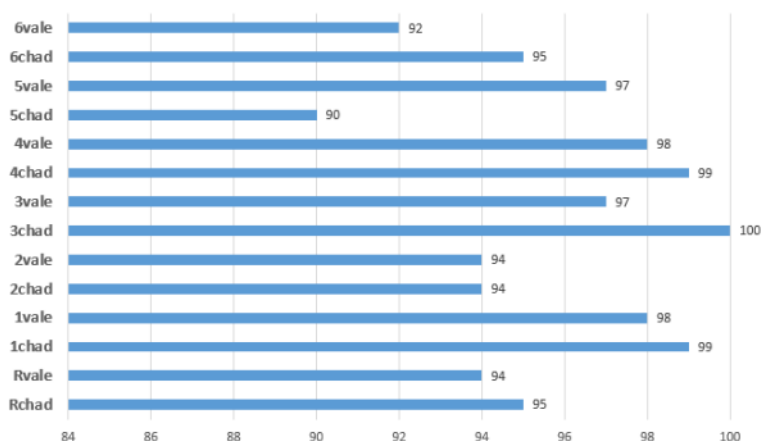
