
### Parent Whatsapp Groups

## Level 2 Games. Inter School Sport Competition: Hockey

Having won the competition for the previous two years our Y4 hockey team travelled to Hollywood Primary School looking last Friday looking to defend their South Birmingham Schools Hockey Title for the second time. A goal by Vely Loufilou was enough to secure a 1-0 victory in the first game against Chilcote 'B'. The second match was another close game with Rujhan Kamboj scoring in a 1-1 draw with Hollywood. The team then found their cutting edge in attack with Rujhan scoring a hat-trick and Teeba Dasher adding another in a 4-0 victory against Radlebar. Another 1-1 draw, this time against Chilcote 'A' meant that we went into the final game knowing that victory would give us a good chance of winning the competition for the third year running. An early goal by Rujhan settled the nerves and a second scored by Teeba secured a 2-0 victory over Bells Farm.



Despite some confusion over a result being incorrectly recorded, the final places were calculated and we are proud to say that the team finished in joint first place with the hosts, Hollywood Primary School. Both teams had won the same number of matches, drawn the same number of games, drawn their fixture, scored the same number of goals and conceded an equal number of goals. With no way to separate the two undefeated teams, it was decided that they should share first place.

The team were a credit to the school and demonstrated excellent teamwork and skill in addition to sportsmanship and respect throughout the tournament. We look forward to returning next year to try and defend our crown and extend our unbeaten run!
