






### General Information

- recounts





the country.



Children also take part in daily spelling and SPAG sessions.






## **Maths**

# Where Should My Child Be?

#### End of Autumn Term

At the end of the Autumn term, 33% of the objectives in each subject should be achieved.

This will be recorded as **EMERGING** or **Y5E**.

#### End of Spring Term

At the end of the Spring term, 66% of the objectives in each subject should be achieved.
