Extract from letter from the Department for Education post-Brexit

'Following the recent EU referendum, there will be questions about how the referendum result affects our reforms to education and social care. As the Prime Minister has already set out, the Government will continue to deliver its manifesto commitments, and will continue taking forward the important legislation set out in the Queen's Speech. The usual business of Government will also continue – ensuring a high quality school place for every child, recruiting and training the best teachers, tackling underperformance wherever it occurs, and keeping children safe.

There will be no immediate changes in the circumstances of European citizens living, studying or working in the UK – current arrangements will continue to apply to European pupils and their families and to teachers, early years and social work professionals and all others who work with children.

All schools will continue to play an important role in promoting the fundamental British values of mutual respect and tolerance for those of all backgrounds and faiths. We are clear that no child should live in fear of racism or bullying, and by law all schools must have a behaviour policy with measures to tackle bullying.'

School Games Day 2016 Part#2!



On Monday morning our Reception and KS1 pupils took part in the second instalment of our end of year sports festival! Each class chose to represent a nation they had studied this year and wear the nation's colours. For example 2 Chad, having recently run a Greek style restaurant as part of their business challenge, represented Greece, so the pupils all made Greek flags and wore blue or white clothes. This mixture of colour, combined with the support and encouragement the pupils offered their class mates, created an excellent atmosphere. There were plenty of brilliant performances on display with pupils showing determination to succeed, whilst remaining sporting and respectful of their opponents. The pupils also got to use our new long jump pit for the first time! The Reception and KS1 School Games Day was the final event in our Inter Form Sport Competition and saw the Chad classes taking on the Vale classes in each year group, in a combination of traditional sports day activities and a range of the Level 1 and 2 Sports our older pupils have competed in this year. Every pupil taking part was able to score points for their team based on their performance. All the points from Chad classes were added up to give a Chad total and the same done for Vale pupils. By the end of the event the teams had scored over 600 points between them and were separated by only 20 points! With Vale winning the KS2 event last week, it was Chad who triumphed in the Reception and KS1 School Games day, adding another 3 points to their total in the overall Inter Form Sport standings.



Chad now lead the overall standings 59-51.

Finally a special mention must go to the Young Sports Leaders from Lordswood Girls' School. 14 Leaders volunteered to help on the day, officiating events, keeping scores and supporting our pupils. They even led the dancing during the closing ceremony!! They did a fantastic job and the day couldn't have worked without them. We hope they are able to come back next year and support us with our School Games Day 2017.
