

Healthy & Active @ Chad Vale Inter Form Sport - Level 1 Games

Rounders - The Year 6 fixture had to be played as an indoor rounders games due to the poor weather we have had lately. This resulted in a very high scoring match. The old saying 'Catches Win Matches' proved especially true in this game, with Vale's fielders unable to prevent the Chad batters from scoring heavily. The Chad team's superiority in the field enabled them to restrict the Vale team to 41 rounders scored over their two innings. Chad were able to chase down this score, achieving the 41.5 rounders required for victory, with 19 balls remaining in their second innings. This victory earned the Chad team another three points towards their overall team total.

A break in the rain last Wednesday meant that Year 5 were able to play their rounders fixture outside. Vale batted first and scored six rounders over their two innings. Once again, some impressive fielding from the Chad side prevented the Vale batters from facing their full compliment of 30 balls in both innings. Vale were restricted to just 3 rounders in their first innings but, thanks to some powerful hitting, were able to score the required 3.5 rounders in their second inning to secure victory. With another 3 points earned Chad now hold a 10 point lead in the overall Inter Form Sport competition.

Chad now lead the overall standings 56-45.

Inter Form Sport - Level 2 Games

Tri Golf – Three weeks ago we took a Year 3/4 team and a Y5/6 team to take part in the Shenley Partnership Level 2 Golf Competition. The 20 pupils involved had a great time at the event, many of whom were representing a school team for the first time! Both teams took part in a circuit of Tri Golf activities designed to test their putting and chipping skills. Thanks to some expert coaching from Tom Hefford in our after school golf club both teams performed very well. The Y5/6 team finished 5th in their competition. With only the first placed team qualifying for the Level 3 Birmingham Final the Y3/4 team finished agonisingly close in 2nd place, only 6 points behind the eventual winners. Although disappointed not to qualify everyone taking part agreed that it had been a great morning and look forward to playing more golf in the future.



Tennis - With a number of a talented tennis players at the school there was competition for places in the teams this this year. With the first placed team qualifying for the Level 3 Birmingham Finals both the Year 3/4 team and Year 5/6 team harboured hopes of qualifying. On a baking hot day at Shenley Academy both teams competed well and impressed the officials and event organisers with their attitude and quality of play. The Year 3/4 team fell just short, finishing in second place in but the Y5/6 team won their event and qualified for the Birmingham finals! Congratulations guys.

WBA 'Euro 2016' Football Competition – Having won the regional qualifier our Y3/4 football team travelled to the West Bromwich Albion Academy to compete in the finals of the tournament. Heavy storms meant the matches had to be played on the 3G pitch in the indoor dome. Unfortunately the team weren't able to match their impressive performances in the qualifiers, and although they scored some excellent goals, they struggled to hold onto the leads they established. It's a shame that they were unable to finish a very successful season with another victory, but the players all enjoyed the excellent facilities and although they were disappointed with their 7th place finish everyone is looking forward to playing for the school again next season.

St. Michael's Football Competition – It's been a difficult season for our Y5/6 team. But after suffering some heavy defeats in their first couple of matches the team has improved throughout the year. Two weeks ago they saved their best performances of the season for the final tournament. For many of the team it was the last chance to represent the school team before moving on to Secondary School, and the players can be very proud of their performances at the competition. Winning the first game 3-0 filled the team with confidence and they showed great spirit to fight back to draw a second game that they were unlucky not to win. In the third game of the group stage they won 2-0 ensuring a place in the knock out phase of the competition, despite losing the final group fixture. Having finished second in the group the team were drawn against Four Dwellings in the quarter final. They gave a fantastic account of themselves in the game, but were beaten 2-0 by the stronger team. It was excellent to finish the season on such a positive note and we look set to have a promising Y5/6 team next year!

Inter Form Sport - Level 3 Games

Tennis - Having won the Level 2 event a fortnight earlier, the Y5/6 tennis team travelled to Cannon Hill Park last Friday to compete in the Level 3 Birmingham Finals. The competition was split into two groups, with each group winner playing off in the Gold Medal Match and the two second placed teams competing in the Bronze Medal Play-Off. The team started slowly, losing their first match but quickly found their rhythm and remained undefeated in the remaining 4 group fixtures. This was enough to secure second place in the group and qualify for the Bronze Medal Play-Off. Although the team gave it their best efforts they were unable to win their final game, losing by 3 rubbers to 1. We would like to offer our congratulations to Moseley School who deservedly won the competition. The players were disappointed not to finish with a medal, but throughout both the Level 2 and 3 competitions they have done the school proud with the quality of their play and exemplary attitude. I think we can all agree that being the 4th best tennis team in Birmingham is an accomplishment that deserves to be recognised. With the majority of the team being made of player from Year 5 we can look forward to having another good crack at the competition next year!


