This week we have been practising to read and spell words with the **air** and **ear** trigraphs in and the **oi** and **short oo** digraphs.

Below are a list of words that contain these letter combinations. Please ask your child to read a small selection of them each day as well as selecting some for them to spell. Remind them to say the word and then segment it into it's individual sounds before they write it (chip - ch - i - p).
