A testing week!

It's been a testing week in all senses as the weather has presented some considerable challenges for children and teachers arriving at (and leaving) school during torrential downpours and the resulting traffic mayhem that this created. Well done to everyone who made it though the floods and got to school! Apart from a few minor issues with our internal drains and the fact that our flat roof turns into a swimming pool during very heavy rain, we've escaped relatively unscathed from the wrath of the weather. It's also been an excellent test of our new roof on the old build and the drainage system on the field, which have both worked very well. We currently have our own Chad Vale stream, as the water run-off from the field and local houses empties off down the drive. Previously this water would have created water-logging and made the school field unusable for weeks!

We'd like say a big thanks to Mrs. Shiner and Mr Custodio this week for ensuring that weather related issues have been kept to a minimum. They have been in early clearing flood water from around the site and from the roof and they spent hours trouble-shooting and mending our electric gate after the blue tits that had been nesting there (in the gate post!) fledged earlier in the week!

Year 1 children carried out the Phonics Screening Check this week and everyone I saw doing the test did their very best, using everything they have learnt in reading skills over the last 2 years. I'd like to say a big thanks to the teachers and support staff who have taught the children this year and Mr. Dubberley for creating an intervention and support program that appears to have transformed our outcomes. We are expecting a big improvement and possibly our best results ever! We have also this week submitted our figures to the local authority for the end of foundation stage; our Reception 'Good Level of Development'. This figure is also up on previous years and looks to be above national and Birmingham figures—thank-you to the Early Years Team and to all the parents who have supported us in KS1 this year! Official data will be published once it's been validated. Let's hope we get better weather for the weekend!
