
## What will we be learning?

## Key knowledge

- Harborne railway station opened on 10 August 1874 but later closed. It is now the Harborne Walkway.
- Has a population of over 23,000.
- Harborne is an area of south-west Birmingham, three miles south of the city centre.
- Harborne has many sports clubs including golf, cricket, tennis, hockey, swimming and bowls.
- Harborne ward forms part of the Birmingham Edgbaston constituency.

## **Glossary**

**grid reference**: a set of numbers used to find particular places on a map land use: what land is used for (such as housing, recreation, farming, etc.)
